When asked about the impact of the program, teachers offered comments such as:

"... It allows students to think about having a conversation with their parents or guardians in terms of safety and a person's wellbeing, whether it is their own or that of someone else. It is also an opportunity for the community members to come to the school and see what kind of learning is taking place and to feel more a part of their youths learning experience. Roots of Empathy in my class allowed us to have conversations that parents may not have with a child, as well as conversations that a normal school curriculum does not call for. It showed the students that everyone is different in all things, from feelings, looks, intelligence, and developmentally."
